Welcome: Edna Garcia gave the welcome and explained her new role on the committee. Committee members introduced themselves and their representation on the committee.

Roles of the Committee: Edna Garcia distributed copies of Sec. 28.004 or the Texas Education Code explaining the functions and duties of the committee.

Program: SuNell Pyeatt, as representative of Compassionate Care Crisis Center, presented the program and materials available at no charge to schools on the Scot Phelps abstinence curriculum. She explained how the program has worked in various schools to facilitate goal – setting and decision making for students in 6th-9th.
