



- Senior Parking Spot Painting form due July 30th to Mrs. Shackelford (kelly.shackelford@plainviewisd.org) or Mrs. Madrigal (rosanna.madrigal@plainviewisd.org).
- Parking spots to be sold on August 3rd to seniors only. If approved, painting can begin. If not approved, painting cannot start until August 6th.
- Painting days – August 3rd and 4th 9-12 and 1:30-7 if applications turned in and approved prior to the 3rd.
- Applications turned in on the 3rd, can check for approval and start painting on August 6th – 9th 9-12 and 1:30-7.
- No painting outside of these days and times.

Senior Parking Spot Painting Regulations

- Student must pay for parking spot (\$20) and painting fee (+\$15) before painting, cash only
- Student must submit painting form for design approval
- Students may not paint parking spot outside of approved days unless arrangements are made beforehand
- Students must cover painting with black water based latex paint by the **WEDNESDAY BEFORE** graduation practice or tickets will be held until covered-up
- If any design outside of that approved is painted, disciplinary actions will occur and the spot will be covered up at the student's expense
- If any graffiti occurs throughout the year, the student will be responsible for covering it up within 48 hours
- If the student is unenrolled, the spot must be covered up before leaving
- Students may not paint their spots past the approved dates (late enrollment/ buying spot late)

Painting Regulations

- **MUST use Exterior Latex Paint (water-based)**
- Students must leave 12 inches between top curb/block and painting and 6 inches on each side of design blank
- No painting over any curb or parking block
- Can only paint pre-approved design
- Design cannot contain any gore, racial slogans/slurs, nudity, violence, profanity, drugs/drug paraphernalia, derogatory terms, etc.
- Students must paint spots during approved dates
