HELD SPRING BREAK "MAKE-UP" FRESHMAN ORIENTATION MARCH 2019 FOR CADETS UNABLE TO ATTEND FIRST ONE AND WHO NEEDED REMEDIAL INSTRUCTION; WELL ATTENDED AND BENEFICIAL. WE NEED TO RESUME ATTENDING BLT AND LA, AND WE NEED TO DO MORE COMMUNITY SERVICE. WE ALSO NEED TO RESUME GETTING MORE PRESS COVERAGE IN OUR LOCAL PAPER FOR OUR MANY ACCOMPLISHMENTS. UNIT'S SCHOOL DISTRICT HAS NEW SUPERINTENDENT WHO SEEMS VERY SUPPORTIVE OF PROGRAM. UNIT RETENTION IS VERY HIGH AND A CORE GROUP OF CADETS IS VERY ACTIVE; CADETS NEED ADDITIONAL HELP WITH ACADEMICS, AS FEW DO WELL ON THE ACT; MANY STRUGGLE WITH THE ASVAB AS WELL. THIS IS LIMITING THEIR POST-HIGH SCHOOL OPPORTUNITIES.
