Requirements

Students are expected to come to class on time and prepared every day with the following supplies:

- Pencil
- Eraser
- Pocket Folder
- Sketchbook or Drawing Paper
- Drawing Pencils (optional)

Participation

- Students are expected to stay on task and work on their project the entire time.
- Students who come to class on time, prepared with all supplies, and remain on task will receive a high participation grade for the day.
- If a student comes unprepared to class more than once a week this will result in lunch detention, calls home, and/ or office referrals.

Projects

- Students will complete several major assignments during the semester in art.
- Students are expected to complete ALL assignments to the best of their ability while fulfilling all of the project requirements.
- All projects must be completed following the rubrics and creative process guides.
- Students will be given several grades for each assignment. A rubric will be provided with each project and assignment.

Grades

- Each student's final grade in art is based on the following criteria:
 - Project Grades
 - Design
 - Craftsmanship
 - Project Participation
 - Process
 - Other Class Assignments and Homework
- All grades are posted on Skyward.
- Late and/or incomplete assignments will not receive full credit.
